



1. Open All Hazards Map All Hazards Map (bc-er.ca)

2. Check box and click I Agree




3. The legend of the map can be found here







4. Layers of the map have been auto populated, and new layers can be added depending on the needs



- 5. Click Fire Buffer Analysis, and select preferred methods to select fire location
 - A. Search by Place:
 - i. Click area on the map with [™] or or symbol
 - ii. Find the Fire Number
 - iii. Enter Fire Number in the search bar
 - iv. Enter desired buffer distance
 - v. Click Report
 - vi. Click , choose CSV format, and click Download











- B. Select Fire Point:
 - i. Select draw mode that is most applicable to the information that you are seeking and follow the same steps for downloading reports
- C. Coordinate:
 - i. Insert Latitude and Longitude value that you have or
 - ii. Enter fire number in the search bar to find the coordinates as they will auto populate when fire number is entered
- 6. Click *Facility Buffer Analysis* to locate fire and assets around the location
 - A. Legal location and Well Authority Number
 - i. Type legal location and it should populate the legal location
 - ii. Follow the steps in section 5 A iii with buffer area and exporting document




- 7. Fire can be located by using Well Authority number, pipeline segments, project number, and legal location.
 - A. Turn on the layers for the information that you are looking for (*Well Surface Hole, Facility Location and Pipeline Segments*).
 - B. Make sure to click on the *Search more* to select the number.








- 8. To add a file
 - A. Click and File
 - B. Drop the file or click *Browse to find the file*
