 - b. This Assignment does not convey any duties or obligations whatsoever to the BC Energy Regulator under or arising from the Agreement.

1. Submit a separate application for each Orphan site. Multiple years of unpaid rent may be applied for in one application.
2. Examples of an energy resource activity, as required in paragraph 1 (a), (b), OR (c) include, but are not limited to a wellsite, facility, pipeline, and energy resource road.
3. A witness must be 19 years of age or older and cannot be a landowner named in the Application, nor the spouse or other family member of a landowner named in the Application.
4. Attach a complete copy of the Surface Lease Agreement and/or Surface Rights Board Order to this Application and mark the first page as Exhibit "A".
5. Attach complete copies of any documents that support this claim for compensation [for example, rent renewal statement(s), cheque stub(s), bank statement(s), and/or any agreement(s) with respect to rent renegotiation, and mark the first page as Exhibit "B".
