

# ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION NOTICE

Application for an Approval Amendment under The Provisions of the Environmental Management Act

We, LNG Canada Development Inc., 400 4th Avenue SW Calgary, Alberta T2P 0J4, intend to submit this amendment application to the Director to amend PE 108429, issued February 3, 2017 and last amended August 24, 2021 which authorizes the discharge of effluent from the LNG Canada marine terminal.

The land upon which the facility is situated and the discharge occurs is Lot 1 District Lots 981, 5469 and 7940, Range 5 Coast District, Plan 12731, located near Kitimat, British Columbia within the traditional territory of the Haisla Nation.

The amendment requests that the following conditions be changed to Permit PE 108469 are made to include:

- the authorized works be changed to an LNG Berth and early construction activities
- the discharge from dewatering activities associated with the construction of LNG Berth (Clause 2.1.1) be authorized until February 29, 2028.
- the discharge monitoring shall be made in accordance with the Marine Monitoring Plan Revision 4, issue date November 27, 2025 and Groundwater Monitoring Plan Revision 1, issue date November 27, 2025.

Any person who may be adversely affected by the proposed amendment and wishes to provide relevant information may, within 30 days after the last date of posting, publishing, service or display, send written comments to the applicant, with a copy to the Regional Manager, Environmental Protection at Sean Babulic, Manager, Environmental Support at BC Energy Regulator at PO Box 9331 Stn Prov Govt, Victoria, BC. V8W 9N3. The identity of any respondents and the contents of anything submitted in relation to this application will become part of the public record.
