ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION NOTICE

Application for a(n) Permit under the provisions of the Environmental Management Act.

We/I, **Harvest Operations Corp. (1000, 700 – 9 Avenue SW, Calgary Alberta T2P 3V4)**, intend to submit this application to the Director to authorize the discharge of treated water from an onsite temporary water treatment system (facility). The source(s) of the discharge is the clean water stream from the facility.

The land upon which the facility will be situated, and the discharge will occur is at **D-47-H/09-4 - I – 09 with PID 90124751, located at the D47 pipeline rupture, at Latitude 58.619572 N and Longitude -120.082497.**

The maximum rate of treat water discharged from this facility will be 25 m3/hr, and the average rate of treated water discharged from this facility will be 15 m3/hr. The operating period for this facility will be 24 hours/day, 7 days/week. The characteristics of the waste discharged from the facility is as follows: treated water discharge containing concentrations of chloride, and various metals less than the applicable BC Water Quality Guidelines (BCWQGs) for the protection of Aquatic Life. The treated water will be returned to the same hydrological system from which it was recovered (i.e., previously impacted land) with lower concentrations of chloride and various metals, thereby preserving the original flow regime and overall site water balance. The type(s) of treatment to be applied to the discharge is comprised of sediment removal (microfiltration/mixed media), followed by membrane treatment by Reverse Osmosis and disinfection similar to drinking water applications.

Any person who may be adversely affected by the proposed discharge of waste and wishes to provide relevant information may, within 30 days after the last date of posting, publishing, service or display, send written comments to the applicant, with a copy to the Director, Environmental Stewardship, at the BC Energy Regulator 6534 100th Avenue, Fort St. John, B.C, V1J 8C5, Waste.Management@bc-er.ca. The identity of any respondents and the contents of anything submitted in relation to this application will become part of the public record.
