Application for an Approval under the Provisions of the Environmental Management Act

We, Coastal GasLink Pipeline Ltd. at 450 1 St SW, Calgary, AB T2P 5H1, intends to submit this waste discharge application to the Director to discharge (wood) waste by burning at five proposed discharge locations. Coastal GasLink (CGL) intends to dispose of non-salvageable woody debris and clean woodwaste (e.g., unusable/damaged mats, skids, and pallets), generated by construction activities in Section West (Construction Section 8) from the Coastal Gas Link Pipeline Project footprint.

The land upon which the proposed five (5) burn locations will be situated, where discharge will occur, is located within the Regional Kitimat-Stikine. Three (3) burn locations will be located between KM 46+950 to KM 51+600 on the North Kitimat Forestry Service Road, the remaining two (2) locations are on the Coastal GasLink Right-of-Way at KP 623+550 and between KP range 621+650 to 621+850, approximately 31 kilometres from Kitimat BC. The burn locations are all within the low smoke zone and will be located at the locations listed below:
