**Order:**

Pursuant to section 49(7) of the *Energy Resource Activities Act* (the Act), I, Dax Bourke, amend General Order 2025-0041-02 issued on December 11, 2025, to Harvest Operations Corp. (Harvest) by extending the date in items 1, 2, 3 and 4 as follows:

1. **By April 15, 2026**, complete a detailed site investigation (as defined in section 39 of the *Environmental Management Act*) of the site located at D-47-H/94-I-9 (the incident site).
2. **By April 30, 2026**, prepare a detailed site investigation report of the incident site in accordance with section 59(3) of the Contaminated Sites Regulation. The report must be prepared by a British Columbia Contaminated Sites Approved Professional.
3. **By April 30, 2026**, prepare a remediation plan for the incident site. The remediation plan must be prepared by a British Columbia Contaminated Sites Approved Professional – Risk Based.
4. **By April 30, 2026**, submit the detailed site investigation report and remediation plan in items 2 and 3 to the BCER at [C&E@bc-er.ca](mailto:C&E@bc-er.ca).

**Conditions:**

- A. This order shall remain in effect until amended or terminated in whole or in part by the BC Energy Regulator.

**Reasons:**

I make this amendment for the following reasons:

- i. On January 22, 2026, Harvest requested a two (2) month extension to all items of the order due to weather conditions causing delays in field work and the need for further sampling to fully complete the required detailed site investigation report.
- ii. I consider this request reasonable.

**Review or Appeal**

Harvest may request a review of this amendment under section 70 of the Act or appeal this amendment under section 72 of the Act. Both a review and an appeal of the amendment cannot be commenced simultaneously.
