Order:

Pursuant to section 50(1)(a) of the *Energy Resource Activities Act* (the Act), I, Patrick Smook, order that Kelor Rentals Ltd. must:

1. Cease all activities associated with items 3 and 4 of General Order 2026-0030-002 (the Order).

Conditions:

- A. This order shall remain in effect until amended or terminated in whole or in part by the BC Energy Regulator (Regulator).

Reasons:

I make this order for the following reasons:

- i. Kelor Rentals Ltd. is the permit holder of the Site.
- ii. On April 14th, 2026, the Regulator issued the Order to Kelor Rentals Ltd.
- iii. Kelor Rentals Ltd. has failed to comply with Items 3 and 4 of the Order.
- iv. As set out in the letter from the Regulator dated May 12, 2026, the Regulator intends to carry out the work identified in Item 3 and 4 of the Order pursuant to section 50(1)(b) of the Act.

- v. I am of the view that this Order is necessary to allow the Regulator to complete the work efficiently.

Review and Appeal

Kelor Rentals Ltd. may request a review of this order under section 70 of the Act by submitting a request for review to: determinationreviews@bc-er.ca.
