Order:

Pursuant to section 38(1)(c) of the *Energy Resource Activities Act* (the Act), I, Patrick Smook, order that Canadian Natural Resources Limited (CNRL) must:

1. Prepare a report that includes an assessment of the impacts to the Natural Range Barrier (NRB), Coplin Creek, located on the east boundary of RAN075986A (Range) associated with the energy resource activities that are near and or cross the NRB as listed below:
