## RE: Warning: Failure to Prevent Spillage S 37(1)(a) Oil and Gas Activities Act

Dear Mr. Lewis,

On October 31, 2018, the BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) was informed through an Incident Report of a valve failure resulting in spillage at C-35-d/94-a-13 location. Through investigation into the spill it was determined that an incorrect sand filter screen was installed allowing sand to pass through into the separator in turn resulting in spillage. ConocoPhillips Canada Resources Corp (ConocoPhillips) is the permit holder for the facility located at C-35-d/94-a-13.

The Commission notes that ConocoPhillips has been cooperative throughout the investigation and has updated policies to ensure this incident will not be repeated.

Given the circumstances, ConocoPhillips is hereby issued a warning under section 37(1)(a) of the Oil and Gas Activities Act for failure to prevent spillage.
