RE: Warning: Fail To Comply With Condition Of A Permit

Dear Mr. Beaulieu,

FortisBC holds a permit issued under the Oil and Gas Activities Act. This authorization contains conditions as follows:

Condition 4

A notice of maintenance activities must be submitted, as per Commission process at least 2 (2) working days prior to the commencement of any changes in or about a stream associated with maintenance activities.

Condition 5

At least ten (10) working days prior to the commencement of any changes in or about a stream associated with maintenance activities, the Permit Holder must provide a notice of works to any First Nation(s) who may have Aboriginal Interests identified, as per the BC First Nations Consultative Areas Database, within the area in which the works are to occur.

On September 14, 2021, the Commission received the required notification via e-mail. This was 33 days past the due date.

The Commission notes that FortisBC has no relevant previous non-compliance history related to late notification of construction reporting.

Given the circumstances, FortisBC is hereby issued a warning only for the following:

FortisBC, on or about August 13, 2021, did fail to comply with the condition of a permit contrary to Section 21(b)(ii) of the Oil and Gas Activities Act.
