**RE: Warning: Fail To Comply With Condition Of An Authorization**

Canadian Spirit Resources Inc. (Canadian Spirit) holds conditional water license c133692 issued under the Water Sustainability Act. This license contains the following condition:

The licence holder shall keep records on daily water withdrawals in units of cubic metres. This information will be submitted to the Water Manager on a quarter-annual basis, on or before January 25, April 25, July 25 and October 25, for the preceding three month period. The requirement for water use reporting can be amended from time to time, as directed by the Water Manager.

This condition provides Canadian Spirit three weeks to compile its water withdrawal data and to submit a report to the Oil and Gas Commission (Commission). A report for the months of October, November and December was due no later than January 25, 2021.

Canadian Spirit was contacted on January 28, 2021 and the Commission received the required report on February 4, 2021.

Canadian Spirit is hereby issued a warning only for the following:

Canadian Spirit, on or about January 26, 2021, at or near Fort St. John in the Province of BC, did fail to comply with the condition of an authorization contrary to Section 106(3)(k) of the Water Sustainability Act.
