**RE: Warning: Fail To Comply With A Condition Of An Authorization**

Dear Fiona Chisholm,

Spartan Delta Corp. (Spartan) held authorization AD 100109443 WU 5384 and AD 100109955 WU 5549, each issued under the Water Sustainability Act. Each authorization contains a standard condition as follows:

*The permit holder must maintain accurate records of all water withdrawal activities throughout the term approved. Water withdrawal records for each diversion point, including "0" values for months where no water was withdrawn, must be recorded monthly. Water withdrawal records must be submitted to the Commission on a quarterly basis via eSubmission. Quarterly reports are due on or before April 25<sup>th</sup>, July 25<sup>th</sup>, October 25<sup>th</sup>, and January 25<sup>th</sup>.*

This condition provides the company 25 days to compile its water withdrawal data and to submit a report to the Oil and Gas Commission (Commission). A report for AD 100109443 for the months of October and November, and a report for AD 100109955 for the months of October, November and December were due no later than January 25, 2022.

On January 31, 2022, the Commission received the required reports. This was 6 days past the due date.

Given the circumstances Spartan is hereby issued a warning only for the following:

Spartan, on or about January 26, 2022, at or near Fort St. John, in the Province of BC, did fail to comply with the condition of an authorization contrary to Section 106(3)(k) of the Water Sustainability Act.
