RE: Fail To Comply With A Condition Of An Authorization

Dear Bill Stadler,

Peaceland Oilfield Services Ltd. holds an authorization issued under the Water Sustainability Act, namely conditional water licence 501448. Conditional water licence 501448 contains the following condition:

The licence holder shall keep records on daily water withdrawals in units of cubic metres. This information must be submitted to the Commission via the relevant process at the time of submission on a quarter-annual basis, on or before January 25, April 25, July 25 and October 25, for the preceding three month period. This requirement for water use reporting can be amended from time to time as directed by the Water Manager.

This condition provides the company 25 days to compile its water withdrawal data and to submit a report to the Oil and Gas Commission (Commission).

A report for the months of January, February and March, 2022, was due no later than April 25, 2022.

The Commission received the required reports on May 10, 2022. This was 15 days past the due date.

Peaceland Oilfield Services Ltd. will be issued a warning only for the following:

Peaceland Oilfield Services Ltd, on or about April 26, 2022 at or near Fort St. John, in the province of B.C., did fail to comply with a condition of an authorization contrary to section 106(3)(k) of the Water Sustainability Act.
