**RE: Warning: Fail to Comply with the Pipeline Crossing Regulation**

Dear Mr. Eggleton,

On July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022, the BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) received a complaint from FortisBC that a trench had been constructed across a FortisBC pipeline without any previous notice given to FortisBC. The land where the incident took place is owned by Eaglepoint Golf Resort (Eaglepoint).

A discussion with Mr. Eggleton determined that BC One Call had not been notified prior to the works commencing. Once Mr. Eggleton was notified by FortisBC, work was stopped until the proper permissions were given by FortisBC. Mr. Eggleton cooperated with the Commission on the investigation.

Given the circumstances, Eaglepoint Golf Resort is hereby issued a warning for the following:

Eaglepoint, on or about July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022, did fail to comply with Section 2(3)(a)(i) of the *Pipeline Crossing Regulation* – Eaglepoint didn't advise BC One Call of the proposed site of the activity.
