**RE: Warning: Fail To Comply With Condition Of An Authorization**

Dear Mr. Young,

Erikson National Energy holds an authorization issued under the Water Sustainability Act. This authorization contains a standard condition as follows:

*The permit holder must maintain accurate records of all water withdrawal activities throughout the term authorized. Water withdrawal records for each diversion point, including "0" values for months where no water was withdrawn, must be recorded monthly. Quarterly reports are due on or before April 25th, July 25th, October 25th, and January 25th, via eSubmission.*

This condition provides the company 25 days to compile its water withdrawal data and to submit a report to the Oil and Gas Commission (Commission). A report for the Quarter 2, 2022 was due no later than July 25, 2022.

On August 4, 2022, the Commission received the required report. This was 10 days past the due date.

Late reporting may result in issuance of a violation ticket. The Commission notes that Erikson National Energy was issued a ticket for non-compliance related to late water withdrawal reporting in June 2021. This violation would have resulted in a second ticket being issued; however, a technical issue prevents a ticket from being issued.

Given the circumstances, Erikson National Energy is hereby issued a warning only for the following:

Erikson National Energy, on or about July 26, 2022, did fail to comply with the condition of an authorization contrary to Section 106(3)(k) of the Water Sustainability Act.
