RE: Warning: Fail To Comply With A Condition Of A Permit

Dear Ms. Begin,

Coastal GasLink Pipeline Ltd. (CGL) holds pipeline permit (Section 2) AD 100082292. Condition 52(f) states the following:

Flow isolation crossings must be planned and conducted in accordance with the relevant detail in the Construction Section 2 Supplemental Stream Crossings Submission that has been submitted to the satisfaction of the Commission, and in accordance with (b) to (g) of condition 50 and the following additional requirements:

f) except with leave of the Commission, pump intakes must not disturb beds of streams or wetlands except as necessary to ensure safe installation and operation of equipment and must be screened with maximum mesh sizes and approach velocities in accordance with the Fisheries and Oceans Canada "Freshwater Intake End-of-Pipe Fish Screen Guideline", as amended from time to time;

On August 18, 2022, an Oil and Gas Commission Compliance and Enforcement Officer conducted an inspection at KP 106+964. GCL was conducting a flow isolation crossing on watercourse 80.1F, a fish bearing stream. The officer inspected the pump intake and determined the fish screen around the box for the pump intake had pulled away from the side of the box thereby allowing fish to enter the box. CGL has subsequently replaced the screen on the box.

Given the circumstances CGL is hereby issued a warning only for the following:

CGL, on or about August 18,2022, at or near Chetwynd, in the Province of B.C. did, while carrying out and oil and gas activity, fail to comply with a condition of a permit contrary to Section 21(b)(ii) of the Oil and Gas Activities Act.
