RE: Warning: Fail To Comply With A Condition Of An Authorization

Dear Moe Ouellet,

Veresen Midstream General Partner Inc. holds a water licence issued under the Water Sustainability Act. This licence contains the following condition:

The license holder shall keep records on daily water withdrawals in units of cubic metres. This information must be submitted to the Commission via the relevant process at the time of submission on a quarter-annual basis, on or before January 25, April 25, July 25, and October 25, for the preceding three month period. This requirement for water use reporting can be amended from time to time as directed by the Water Manager.

This condition provides the company 25 days to compile its water withdrawal data and to submit a report to the Oil and Gas Commission (Commission). A report for the months of October, November and December, 2022, was due no later than January 25, 2023.

On January 30, 2023, the Commission received the required report. This was 5 days past the due date.

Late reporting may result in issuance of a violation ticket. The Commission notes that Veresen Midstream General Partner Inc. has no previous non-compliance history related to late water withdrawal reporting.

Given the circumstances, Veresen Midstream General Partner Inc. is hereby issued a warning only for the following:

Veresen Midstream General Partner Inc., on or about January 26, 2023, at or near Fort St. John, in the Province of BC, did fail to comply with the condition of an authorization contrary to Section 106(3)(k) of the Water Sustainability Act.
