RE: Warning : Fail To Comply With A Condition Of An Authorization

Dear Vincent Wei,

Pacific Canbriam Energy Limited holds water authorizations AD 100114354 and AD 100114355 issued under the Water Sustainability Act. These authorization contain a standard condition as follows:

The permit holder must maintain accurate records of all water withdrawal activities throughout the term authorized. Water withdrawal records for each diversion point, including '0' values for months where no water was withdrawn, must be recorded monthly. Water withdrawal records must be submitted to the Commission on a quarterly basis via eSubmission. Quarterly reports are due on or before April 25, July 25, October 25 and January 25.

This condition provides the company 25 days to compile its water withdrawal data and to submit a report to the BC Energy Regulator (Regulator). A report for the months of February and March, 2023, was due no later than April 25, 2023 for each authorization.

On May 4, 2023, the Regulator received the required reports. This was ten days past the due date. Late reporting may result in issuance of a violation ticket. The Regulator notes that Pacific Canbriam Energy Limited has no recent previous non-compliance history related to late water withdrawal reporting.

Given the circumstances, Pacific Canbriam Energy Limited is hereby issued a warning only for the following:

Pacific Canbriam Energy Limited, on or about April 26, 2023, at or near Fort St. John, in the Province of BC, did fail to comply with the condition of an authorization contrary to Section 106(3)(k) of the Water Sustainability Act.
