RE: Warning: Fail To Comply With A Requirement of Integrity Management

Dear Trevor Mahon,

Vermilion Energy Inc. holds a number of pipeline assets in British Columbia (BC). As part of pipeline integrity management, a permit holder who operates a pipeline must be an active member of BC One Call and provide BC One Call with current records of pipeline assets. Section 7(5)(b) of the Pipeline Regulation states the following:

- (5) A pipeline permit holder must not construct, operate, maintain, repair, deactivate or abandon a pipeline approved by the permit, unless
 - (b) the holder is a member of BC One Call and the holder's records with BC One Call are current.

On October 4, 2023 the Regulator was informed that Vermilion Enery Inc was not an active member of BC One Call. Vermilion Energy Inc was registered as a corporation in BC on January 10, 2023, and became an active member of BC One Call on December 4, 2023, which was 11 months between registration as a Corporation, and becoming a member of BC One Call. The Regulator notes that Vermilion Energy Inc. has no previous non-compliance history related to membership with BC One Call.

Given the circumstances, Vermilion Energy Inc. is hereby issued a warning only for the following: Vermilion Energy Inc., between January 10, 2023 and December 4, 2023, at or near Fort St. John, in the Province of BC, did fail to comply with the requirement to be a member of BC One Call and provide current records to BC One Call, contrary to Section 7(5)(b) of the Pipeline Regulation.
