RE: Fail To Comply With A Condition Of An Authorization

Dear Mark McCaskill,

Vancouver Airport Fuel Facilities Corporation was issued conditional water licence C133960 on October 17, 2017. Condition j of the authorization states the following:

The license holder shall keep records on daily water withdrawals in units of cubic meters. This information will be submitted to the Commission via the relevant process at the time of submission on a quarter-annual basis, on or before January 25, April 25, July 25 and October 25, for the preceding three month period. The requirement for water use reporting can be amended from time to time, as directed by the Water Manager.

On November 1, 2023, the Regulator contacted Vancouver Airport Fuel Facilities Corporation as their Q3 submission had not been received by October 25, 2023, as required by condition j.

The report was received on November 7, 2023.

Given the circumstances, Vancouver Airport Fuel Facilities Corporation will be issued a warning for failure to comply with a condition of their water authorization:

Vancouver Airport Fuel Facilities Corporation, on or about October 26, 2023, at or near Fort St. John, in the Province of BC, did fail to comply with a condition of a water authorization contrary to section 106(3)(k) of the Water Sustainability Act.
