Dear Emerson Loewen,

Albright Flush Systems Ltd. (Albright) holds water license 503048 issued under the Water Sustainability Act. Condition (i) of the water licence states the following:

The licence holder shall keep records on daily water withdrawals in units of cubic metres. This information must be submitted to the Commission via the relevant process at the time of submission on a quarter-annual basis, on or before January 25, April 25, July 25 and October 25, for the receding three month period. This requirement for water use reporting can be amended from time to time as directed by the Water Manager.

This condition provides the company 25 days to compile its water withdrawal data and to submit a report to the BC Energy Regulator (Regulator). A report for the month(s) of October, November, and December, 2024, was due no later than January 25, 2025.

On January 30, 2025, the Regulator received the required report after contacting Albright. This was 5 days past the due date. The Regulator notes that Albright has no previous late reporting non-compliances.

Given the circumstances, Albright will be issued a warning only for the following:

Albright, on or about January 26, 2025, at or near Fort St. John, in the Province of BC, did fail to comply with the condition of an authorization contrary to Section 106(3)(k) of the Water Sustainability Act.
