RE: Warning : Fail To Comply With A Condition Of An Authorization

Dear Brad Vollmin,

R360 Environmental Solutions Canada Inc. (R360) holds water license C500172 issued under the Water Sustainability Act. This authorization contains a standard condition as follows:

The license holder shall keep records on daily water withdrawals in units of cubic metres. This information must be submitted to the Commission via the relevant process at the time of submission on a quarter-annual basis, on or before January 25, April 25, July 25 and October 25, for the preceding three month period. This requirement for water use reporting can be amended from time to time as directed by the Water Manager

This condition provides the company 25 days to compile its water withdrawal data and to submit a report to the BC Energy Regulator (Regulator). A report for the months of April, May, June, 2025, was due no later than July 25, 2025.

On July 31, 2025 the Regulator received the required report. This was 6 days past the due date. Late reporting may result in issuance of a violation ticket. The Regulator notes that R360 has no history related to late water withdrawal reporting.

Given the circumstances, R360 is hereby issued a warning only for the following:
R360, on or about July 26, 2025, at or near Fort St. John, in the Province of BC, did fail to comply with the condition of an authorization contrary to Section 106(3)(k) of the Water Sustainability Act.
