RE: Warning: Burn Without Authority

Dear Mr. Steinwand,

On June 19, 2019 Commission staff conducted an inspection of PETRONAS Energy Canada Ltd. (PETRONAS) storage yard located at c-048-J/094-B-016. During the inspection a burn pile was noted with remnants of wood bridge deck material and steel.

PETRONAS has admitted that woody debris comprised of bridge decking, swamp and rig mat materials were burned at the subject location on December 16, 2017. PETRONAS had obtained a burn reference number and believed that was all that was required to do the burning. They did not have a permit or approval from Ministry of Environment.

Burning or incineration of waste means the burning, partial burning or incineration of waste material generated from an industry, trade or business and requires a permit from Ministry of Environment.

It is noted that PETRONAS has no previous non-compliance for illegal burning. Given the circumstances, PETRONAS is hereby issued a warning only for the following:

PETRONAS, on or about December 16, 2017, at or near Fort St. John in the Province of BC, did introduce or cause or allow to be introduced into the environment, waste produced by a prescribed activity or operation contrary to section 6(3) of the Environmental Management Act.
