RE: Fail To Comply With Section 7(1)(a) Pipeline Regulation Fail To Comply With Section 78.1 Drilling and Production Regulation

Dear Mr. Faizi,

On September 11, 2018 Tallahassee Exploration Inc. (Tallahassee) acquired numerous active pipelines and facilities in B.C.

On December 12, 2019 the Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) e-mailed Tallahassee a Self-Assessment and Declaration Form for an integrity management program for facilities (IMPF) and an integrity management program for pipelines (IMPP).

On January 31, 2020 Tallahassee informed the Commission that they were just in the process of developing the required IMPP and IMPF.

Tallahassee has committed to implementing both an IMPF and IMPP by June 30, 2020.

Section 7(1)(a) of the Pipeline Regulation states:

A pipeline permit must not operate a pipeline approved by the permit unless the holder has prepared a pipeline integrity management program for the pipeline that complies with CSA Z662 and Annex N of CSA Z662

Section 78.1 of the Drilling and Production Regulation states:

A facility permit holder must prepare and maintain an integrity management program and carry out operations in accordance with the integrity management program throughout the life cycle of the facility.

Given the circumstances, Tallahassee is hereby warned for failing to comply with section 7(1)(a) of the Pipeline Regulation and section 78.1 of the Drilling and Production Regulation.

If Tallahassee fails to implement the required IMPF and IMPP further action may be taken.
