PERMISSIONS

Oil and Gas Activities Act

- 1. The BC Oil and Gas Commission ("the Commission"), under section 25 (1) of the *Oil and Gas Activities Act* hereby permits the holder to construct and maintain an oil and gas road, subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) The permissions and authorizations granted under this permit are limited to the area described in construction plan Document No: 195.0.1.0_OGC_CONST, Revision 0, dated February 16, 2015 (the "construction plan") by McElhanney Geomatics Professional Land Surveying Ltd. as submitted to the Commission in the permit application dated November 19, 2015 (hereinafter referred to as the "operating area").
 - (2) Following initial construction of the road, future permission to construct is limited to required modifications within the operating area except as otherwise restricted by this permit.

CONDITIONS

Notification:

- 2. The permit holder must submit the post-construction plan, as per section 11 of the Oil and Gas Road Regulation, as an ePASS shape file and PDF plan accurately identifying the location of the total area actually disturbed under this permit. The shapefile and plan must be submitted to postconstructionplan@bcogc.ca.
- 3. The permit holder must notify the Nisga'a Lisims Government a minimum of five (5) days prior to commencement of activities.

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Archaeology

- 4. If artifacts, features, materials or things protected under section 13(2) of the Heritage Conservation Act are identified the permit holder must, unless the permit holder holds a permit under section 12 of the Heritage Conservation Act issued by the Commission in respect of that artifact, feature, material or thing:
 - a. immediately cease all work in the vicinity of the artifacts, features, materials or things;
 - b. immediately notify the Commission and the Archaeology Branch of the Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations
 - c. refrain from resuming work in the vicinity of the artifacts, features, materials or things except in accordance with an appropriate mitigation plan that has been prepared in accordance with the Heritage Conservation Act and approved by the Archaeology Branch of the Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations.

ADVISORY GUIDANCE

1. The term "unused equipment" has the same definition as in the Drilling and Production Regulation.
