

EFFECTIVE DATE: Immediately

Due to an improvement in drought conditions, all water diversion suspensions have now ended for the oil and gas industry in the Peace River and Liard River watersheds in northeast B.C. On Aug. 20, 2018 the BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) suspended all previously approved water diversions under Section 10 of the Water Sustainability Act due to drought conditions.

Suspensions have now ENDED for all rivers, streams and lakes in the following basins:

Peace River watershed

- **Beatton River**
- **Blueberry River** Lynx Creek
- Cache Creek • Milligan Creek •
- **Cameron River** Kotcho River ٠
- Chinchaga River • Shekilie River
- Johnson Creek

No water diversion suspensions remain in place in the above watersheds.
