## Archaeology Process Guidelines and Archaeological Assessment Information Forms Update

TO: Industry Clients

EFFECTIVE DATE: Feb. 7, 2011

A revised version of the BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) Archaeology Process Guidelines (Guidelines) and the associated Archaeological Assessment Information Forms (AAIF) have been placed on the Commission website. The AAIFs are now separated for geophysical and non-geophysical applications. The revised Guidelines reflect the Oil and Gas Activities Act formatting and support the new AAIFs.

There will be a one month transition period during which the Commission will accept the older AAIF format. Effective Feb. 7, 2011 clients are asked to ensure they are using the revised Guidelines and AAIFs.
