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INFORMATION BULLETIN

Clarification for Area Table Submission

FORT ST. JOHN – The BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) is clarifying information needed for submission of Area Table details of pipeline Construction Plan(s).

The Area Table within a pipeline Construction Plan defines areas of the disturbance and must show the total area of disturbance in land based hectares related to the pipeline right of way. The breakdown of area by segment is no longer required.

The “From and To”(s) location, with corresponding UTM's (Universal Transverse Mercator), of each segment must be indicated on the Construction Plan as per current practice.

Pipe specifications, diameter class and segment length, are broken down in the engineering section of KERMIT upon application submission and do not need to be included on the Construction Plan.

Previously, Area Table detail required the breakdown of hectares by pipeline segment, the Commission is advising this is no longer required as the submission in land based hectares will standardize information received by the Commission, assisting clients and staff through a more efficient and streamlined process.
