Commission Changing to New Email Addresses

EFFECTIVE DATE: June 4, 2011

BACKGROUND:

The BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) is approaching the next stage in moving its computer system to a new network and all Commission staff are receiving new email addresses. The email, website and ongoing network changes provide the Commission with improved network security, help reinforce our role as an independent regulator and allow for innovation. The new email addresses are consistent with the Commission's new internet address www.bcogc.ca.

New email addresses will come into effect on June 4, 2011 as Firstname.Lastname@bcogc.ca. All mail sent to an old email address will generate a bounce back message to the sender (for two months) with information about the change and the receiver's new email address. In order to correctly reach someone at the Commission, senders must use the new email address after June 4. It's recommended you update your addresses of contacts within the Commission at that time. The Commission's phone list on the website, as well as many of the online reports and documents, will be updated with new contact information.
