## **Hydraulic Fracture Summary Data Available**

**EFFECTIVE:** Immediately

## **BACKGROUND**:

The BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) is now posting detailed hydraulic fracturing stimulation summary data on its <u>website</u>. This information is populated from Fracdata (refer to <u>Industry Bulletin 2013-03</u>), an online system for reporting hydraulic fracturing data launched in 2013.

Data is updated monthly. Well completion information is held confidential for a time period based on well classification.

To access, log in under <u>Web Applications</u>, click on Data Downloads and open the Hydraulic Fracture Summary Data csv zip file. There are three csv files available:

- Hydraulic fracture data
- · Perforation data
- Perforation net intervals data

The first row in each csv file is a header line, followed by well data in Well Permit (WA) Number order. A detailed description of each file is available <a href="here">here</a> under "Additional Information".

The collection and dissemination of well data is an important function of the Commission, providing information for both effective regulation and a basis for industry development decisions. These three new summary files have been created in addition to existing completion data files available on Data Downloads in "Drilling Data for all wells in B.C.".
