The manual is intended to provide a reference document for oil and gas permit holders detailing the requirements and expectations for Certificate of Restoration applications made to the Commission.

This draft manual now replaces Information Letter 06-14, as it provides detail on existing requirements and expectations to obtain a certificate of restoration, including:

- an overview of site certification
- references to the legislation which provides the basis for the oil and gas site restoration processes
- requirements for:
 - site screening
 - site investigation
 - site remediation
 - Certificate of Restoration Part 1 and 2 applications
- the Commission's Restoration Verification Audit Program process.
