## Geophysical and Drilling Waste Reporting Moves to eSubmission

EFFECTIVE DATE: Oct. 5, 2015

The eSubmission portal, launched on Apr. 20, 2015, will be accepting Geophysical and Drilling Waste Disposal Reports beginning on Oct. 5, 2015. The portal is part of a suite of projects in the Commission's <u>Business Transition Strategy</u> (BTS) aimed at streamlining and digitizing application and data submission processes.

Both the Geophysical portal and Drilling Waste Disposal portal have been migrated to the eSubmission platform in-kind. As such, both applications have the same functionality and work flow. Access to the existing portals will cease as of Oct. 5, 2015 and users will be redirected to the <u>eSubmission portal</u>.

Users will be able to access the eSubmission portal using their existing credentials and security roles that were used to access the Geophysical and/or Drilling Waste Disposal portals. If you have existing credentials, no further action is required. If you do not have Geophysical and/or Drilling Waste Disposal portal credentials and require access to the eSubmission portal, please see the <a href="External Kermit Administration How To">External Kermit</a> Administration How To document for instructions.
