

INDUSTRY BULLETIN 2016-06

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Requirement for Individual Ownership Plans

The BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) is now requiring new oil and gas activity applications to contain Individual Ownership Plans (IOP).

The Commission requires applicants, where applicable, to submit an IOP along with their application package. An IOP is only required for private land where a land owner is directly impacted and a surface agreement is required.

The purpose of the IOP is to allow land owners directly impacted by an oil and gas activity to easily identify the area of their land that has been permitted for an oil and gas activity.
