Account Setup Required for New AMS Payment Portal

EXPECTED EFFECTIVE DATE: JULY 11, 2016

As part of the Business Transition Strategy to transform paper-based oil and gas application processes to digital, the BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) is advising applicants to complete the registration process for the new online payment portal, AMS Payment.

AMS Payment is a secure payment platform that allows industry to pay for application fees online via Electronic Fund Transfer. AMS Payment forms part of the new Application Management System, which is expected to launch on July 11, 2016. At that time most oil and gas applications and associated fees will be submitted and paid for online through the new portal, replacing the Commission's existing paper-based processes.

Until the launch in July, the Commission's existing payment process will function as normal.
