Registration Open for Application Management System and eSubmission Training

The BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) is announcing new training sessions for users of eSubmission and the Application Management System (AMS). Registration is now open for this training.

Training sessions will be held at the Commission's office on Airport Road in Fort St. John, and also remotely via GoToMeeting. The sessions will take place the week commencing Oct. 24 and include the following:

- eSubmission: Short Term Water Use.
- eSubmission: Post Construction Plans and Preliminary Statutory Rights of Way Survey Plans.
- AMS Spatial and Data Submission Standards.
- AMS Spatial Data Submission Scenarios.
- The Application Management System: Introduction.
- The Application Management System: Advanced.
- AMS Payment: Session available on request.

However, registration is required for each attendee and space is limited.
