Commission Launches Groundwater Review Assistant

The BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) has launched a web-based groundwater information retrieval tool called the Groundwater Review Assistant (GWRA).

The GWRA assists with the retrieval and compilation of groundwater-related information to support projects or tasks requiring hydrogeological review or assessment. It allows users to specify a location of interest and search radius to define the area for data retrieval. Based on these specifications, the GWRA retrieves data from public provincial databases and compiles it in a user-friendly report.

The GWRA is useful to hydrogeologists and other stakeholders to compile data to support:

- Preparation of groundwater licence applications.
- · Completion of risk assessments.
- · Development of groundwater monitoring or protection programs.
- Development of site assessment or remediation programs.

The <u>GWRA</u> and the associated <u>User Guide</u> are available on the <u>Water Information Page</u> of the Commission website.

The GWRA was developed by Foundry Spatial Ltd. in consultation with the Commission under funding from the BC Oil and Gas Research and Innovation Society.
