Changes to Required Well Data Reported through eSubmission

EFFECTIVE DATE: April 9, 2018

The BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) is advising operators that Surface Casing Vent Flow (SCVF), Gas Migration (GM) and Abandoned Well Leak (AWL) reports must be submitted through <u>eSubmission</u>. After April 9, 2018, SCVF, GM and AWL reports submitted to the <u>OGCDrilling.Production@bcogc.ca</u> email address will not be accepted and the permit holder will be directed to the eSubmission portal.

In order to submit reports on behalf of a permit holder, eSubmission users must have the "DRILL COMP PROD REP" Security Role. Guidance for submitting SCVF, GM and AWL reports can be found in the updated <u>eSubmission User Guide</u>.

In addition, the existing <u>SCVF/GM Information form</u> will no longer be available for download. The <u>Oil and Gas</u> <u>Activity Operations Manua</u>l will be updated to reflect these changes.

Permit holders are reminded that each well must be checked for evidence of a SCVF, as specified in section 41(2) of the <u>Drilling and Production Regulation (DPR)</u>. Reporting of discovered SCVF or GM is required under sections 41(3), 41(4) and 41(4.1) of the DPR.
