Update to Well Event Status Prior to Petrinex

EFFECTIVE DATE: Aug. 1, 2018

Prior to B.C.'s switch to Petrinex on Nov. 5, 2018, permit holders should be aware the BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) is updating some well event status data in our systems.

This data change will affect active completion events that have not reported production or injection / disposal in the last 12 reporting periods, or have never reported production or injection / disposal and not had a status change in the past 12 months. In these cases, the event status will be changed to suspended (SUSP) with a status effective date of August 1, 2018.

Permit holders cannot report production, injection or disposal to a suspended completion event. If a permit holder wishes to change the suspended status to active, they may do the following:

- Prior to Petrinex implementation on November 5, a BC-11 form can be submitted to change the status to active.
- Once Petrinex is live on November 5, this can be changed by the permit holder in Petrinex.

Observation wells, which do not report volumetric data and are managed by a separate program, are not affected.
