Reminder of Systems Outage in Preparation for Petrinex

EFFECTIVE: Oct. 26, 2018

The BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) is reminding users there will be an outage of some systems during the transition over to Petrinex. **This outage will be between 5:00 p.m., October 26 and 8:00 a.m., November 1 (PDT).** This was initially communicated in <u>INDB 2018-22.</u> Please check the outage status posted on the <u>Online Services</u> page of our website. Some systems may be available sooner than November 1.

Systems affected are:

- Application Management System (AMS), including AMS Payment.
- eSubmission.
- KERMIT (including incident reporting).
- Corporate Registry.
- Well Lookups and Reports.
- Data Downloads.
- Geology Facility System.
- Activity Level Reports.

As a reminder, emergency protocol during the outage will be as follows:

Minor Incidents

Minor incidents must still be reported to the Commission within 24 hours. For minor incidents during the outage period, permit holders are to fill out Form A: Minor Incident Notification Form and the Incident Classification Matrix available on bcogc.ca. The fillable forms should be completed and emailed to emp@bcogc.ca and the Commission's Emergency Officer at ogc.emergencyofficer@bcogc.ca. For spill incidents, a DGIR number, obtained through Emergency Management BC, is still required and must be included on the form sent to the Commission. Once systems are restored, permit holders are responsible for submitting all minor incidents into the system which took place during the outage.

Level 1, 2 and 3 Incidents

For all reportable spills and level 1, 2 and 3 emergency incidents, permit holders should continue to use the normal protocols, including notifying Emergency Management BC at 1-800-663-3456 and stating that the incident is an oil and gas emergency.
