The Ministry of Energy and Mines Core Storage Facility in Charlie Lake is the provincial repository for oil and gas related core and drill cutting samples. This facility provides a public archive and access to cores and cuttings.

The BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) will assume staffing responsibilities for the core facility from the Ministry of Energy and Mines as of April 2, 2012.
