



Compliance Management and Enforcement Manual Available

BACKGROUND

The BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) has released its Compliance Management and Enforcement Manual, providing information about the Compliance Management System. It outlines processes and requirements for permit holders to address operational non-compliances and contraventions.

The manual provides an overview of inspection practices, fact collecting and documentation processes followed by Commission staff in an investigation as well as proceedings for formal compliance enforcement. Deficiency notice and correction processes are also described as well as permit-holder self-disclosure procedures.

All permit holders are encouraged to review the manual which can be found on the Commission [website](#).

The Commission is a single-window regulator with responsibilities for overseeing oil and gas operations in the province of British Columbia. The role of the compliance and enforcement unit is to ensure oil and gas activities are carried out in accordance with the Oil and Gas Activities Act and associated regulations.
