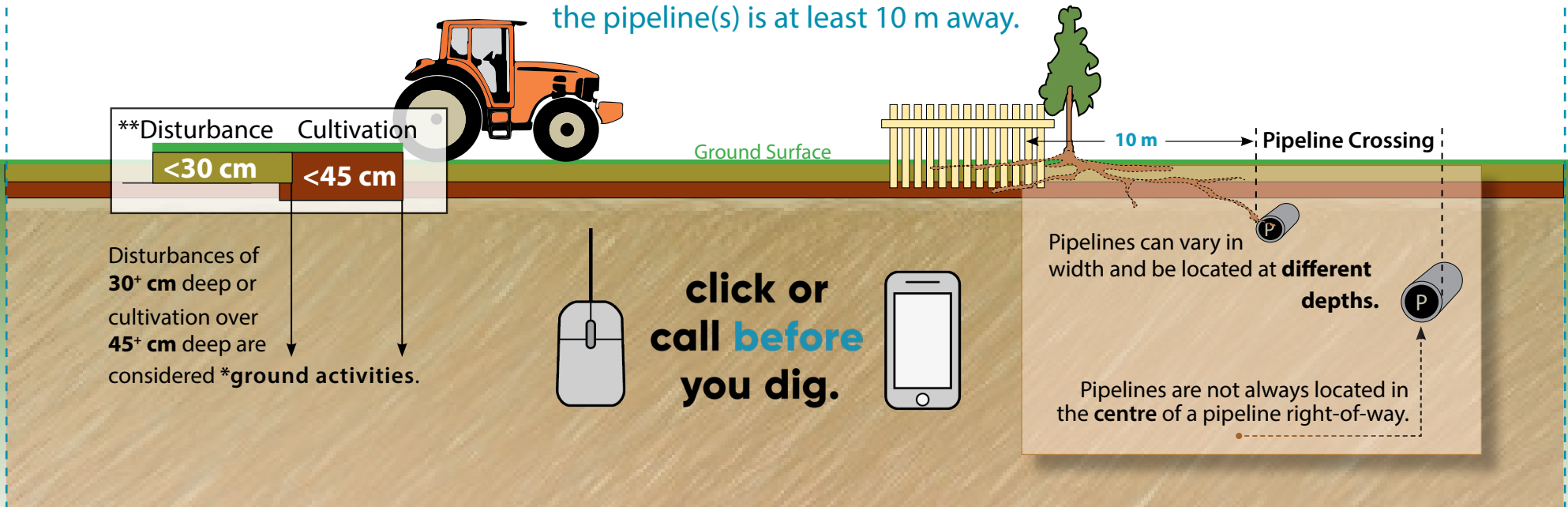

CONTACT BC 1 CALL within 30 m of pipeline/s

BC 1 Call can help connect you with members (pipeline owners) who can confirm if there is a pipeline(s) within 30 m of your proposed activity, and if so, establish if the pipeline(s) is at least 10 m away.



*Ground activities are activities that disturb the earth (such as excavation), but do not include cultivation less than 45 cm deep, or disturbances less than 30 cm deep. If you are cultivating under 45 cm or performing a ground disturbance under 30 cm, there is no requirement to call BC1C.

**Disturbance and Cultivation depths not to scale.



These requirements apply to BC Energy Regulator (BCER) regulated pipelines.
