**RE: PRODUCED WATER DISPOSAL SPECIAL PROJECT CANCELLATION
CNOOC BEAVER d-64-K/94-N-16 (WA# 325)
BEAVER RIVER FIELD – MATTSON 'A' POOL**

The subject well was drilled in 1958 and remained unused until completed in the Mattson 'A' pool in 1970 and later was approved for disposal into the Mattson in 1971. The well was used for disposal from 1972 to 1978 and was later abandoned in 1983. The well was re-entered and re-completed in the Mattson 'A' pool 1989 and was again approved for disposal on November 9th, 1989. Disposal operation occurred from 1990 to 2014 and the Mattson formation was subsequently abandoned in 2016 with a total lifetime cumulative disposal volume of 1,104 e³m³. On March 3rd, 2022, CNOOC Petroleum North America ULC indicated to the Commission via email communication that they have no plans for future disposal and concurred that cancellation of the disposal approval is appropriate.

Pursuant to the *Oil and Gas Activities Act* (OGAA) section 75(2)(b), the Commission may cancel, suspend or amend a designation (iii) if the Commission considers that the designation is spent, or (iv) if the Commission considers that the designation is no longer appropriate, including, without limitation, for reasons of (a) public safety, (b) protection of the environment, or (c) conservation of petroleum and natural gas resources.

The Special Project Approval 90-02-002 for the Beaver field, Mattson 'A' pool formation well CNOOC Beaver d-64-K/94-N-16 (WA 325) is hereby cancelled under section 75(2)(b) of OGAA. In accordance with Section 75(2)(b)(iii), the Commission considers that the designation is spent.
