**RE: PRODUCED WATER DISPOSAL SPECIAL PROJECT CANCELLATION
PETRONAS ET AL JEDNEY b-68-J/94-G-1 (WA #498)
JEDNEY FIELD – BALDONNEL/UPPER CHARLIE LAKE ‘A’ POOL**

The subject well was drilled and completed into the Baldonnel/Upper Charlie Lake ‘A’ pool in 1959 for the production of gas. The well produced from March of 1960 to October of 1965. On November 17th, 1966, the well was approved for disposal into the Baldonnel/Upper Charlie Lake ‘A’ pool. Disposal operation occurred from September of 1969 to October of 2015, with a cumulative injected volume of 888,000 m³. On December 16th, 2020, PETRONAS Energy Canada Ltd. indicated to the Commission via email that they had no plans for further disposal operations and concurred that cancellation of the approval is appropriate.

Pursuant to the *Oil and Gas Activities Act (OGAA)* section 75(2)(b), the Commission may cancel, suspend or amend a designation (iii) if the Commission considers that the designation is spent, or (iv) if the Commission considers that the designation is no longer appropriate, including, without limitation, for reasons of (a) public safety, (b) protection of the environment, or (c) conservation of petroleum and natural gas resources.

The Special Project Approval 66-02-001 for the Jedney field, Baldonnel/Upper Charlie Lake ‘A’ pool well Petronas et al Jedney b-68-J/94-G-1 (WA #498) is hereby cancelled under section 75(2)(b) of OGAA. In accordance with Section 75(2)(b)(iii), the Commission considers that the designation is spent.
