IN THE MATTER of a scheme of Murphy Oil Company Ltd. for Salt Water Disposal (SWD) in the Halfway Formation in the well Murphy et al N Boundary 11-30-87-14 W6M (WA 3098).

The Ministry of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources, pursuant to section 116 of the <u>Petroleum and Natural Gas Act</u>, hereby orders as follows:

- 1. The SWD scheme of Murphy Oil Company Ltd. (operator) for disposal of produced water into the Halfway Formation at well 11-30-87-14 W6M as such scheme is described in the application from the operator to the ministry dated January 15, 1993, is hereby approved, subject to the terms and conditions herein contained.
- 2. The water disposal interval must be in the Halfway Formation.
- 3. A record of volumes disposed of through this well should be included on a Monthly Injection/Disposal Statement. The statement should be submitted to the Victoria office not later than the 25th day of the month following the reported month.
- 4. This approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
