PRODUCED WATER DISPOSAL SPECIAL PROJECT CANCELLATION

CNRL BUICK d-58-I/94-A-11 (WA# 3996)

BUICK CREEK FIELD – UPPER HALFWAY FORMATION

The subject well was drilled and completed in the Lower Halfway 'B' pool in 1977 as an oil well and was later converted to a water injection well in 1999. In 2004, the Upper Halfway zone was completed for water injection. The well was approved for salt water disposal into the Upper Halfway formation on July 5th, 2004 but disposal operations never occurred. In 2012, both the Upper Halfway and Lower Halfway zones were abandoned. On November 7th, 2019, Canadian Natural Resources Ltd. indicated having no plans for reactivation of this well and concurred that cancellation of the disposal approval is appropriate.

Pursuant to the *Oil and Gas Activities Act (OGAA)* section 75(2)(b), the Commission may cancel, suspend or amend a designation (iii) if the Commission considers that the designation is spent, or (iv) if the Commission considers that the designation is no longer appropriate, including, without limitation, for reasons of (a) public safety, (b) protection of the environment, or (c) conservation of petroleum and natural gas resources.

The Special Project Approval 04-02-010 for the Buick Creek field, Upper Halfway formation well CNRL Buick d-58-l/94-A-11 (WA 3996) is hereby cancelled under section 75(2)(b) of OGAA. In accordance with Section 75(2)(b)(iii), the Commission considers that the designation is spent.
