RE: APPLICATION FOR SALT WATER DISPOSAL PC Gulf Milo c-58-E/94-J-10, (WA# 7830); Slave Point Formation

This is with respect to your application dated December 13, 2001 requesting disposal of produced water into the Slave Point formation of the subject well.

Notice of your application was published in the BC Gazette with January 10, 2002 being the deadline for any valid objection. Penn West Petroleum Ltd. (Penn West) in a letter dated December 20, 2001 objected to the scheme approval. The Commission concurs that the Penn West objection has technical merit. Approval of a salt water disposal scheme in the subject well could risk gas recovery from the offsetting Slave Point gas well a-67-E/94-J-10, operated by Penn West. Furthermore, the subject well could be completed as a potential gas well, as proposed in your application.

In view of the above, we wish to advise that your application for salt water disposal cannot be approved at this time.
