## **APPROVAL 97-02-001**

## <u>PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS ACT (the "Act")</u> THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA MINISTRY OF EMPLOYMENT AND INVESTMENT ENERGY AND MINERALS DIVISION

IN THE MATTER of a scheme of Talisman Energy Inc. (the "Operator") for Salt Water Disposal (SWD) in the Slave Point Formation in the well Talisman Sextet b-34-K/94-I-12 (WA 9475).

The Minister of Employment and Investment, pursuant to section 116 of the Act, hereby orders as follows:

- 1. The SWD scheme of the Operator for disposal of produced water in the Slave Point Formation at well b-34-K/94-I-12 as such scheme is described in the application from the Operator to the Ministry dated December 18, 1996 is hereby approved, subject to terms and conditions herein contained.
- 2. The water disposal interval must be in the Slave Point Formation.
- 3. A record of volume of salt water disposed of through this well must be included on a Monthly Injection/Disposal Statement, in the prescribed form, which should be submitted to the Energy and Minerals Division not later than the 25th day of the month following the reported month.
- 4. The disposal/injection pressure at the sandface must not exceed the formation fracture pressure.
- 5. This approval may be modified or rescinded by the Director of the Engineering and Operations Branch at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
