IN THE MATTER of a scheme of Suncor Inc. (the "Operator") for Salt Water Disposal (SWD) in the Blueberry Debolt "A" pool in the well Suncor et al Blueberry c-40-K/94-A-12 (WA 9939).

The Minister of Employment and Investment, pursuant to section 116 of the <u>Petroleum and Natural Gas Act</u>, hereby orders as follows:

- 1. The SWD scheme of the Operator for disposal of produced water in the Debolt "A" pool at well c-40-K/94-A-12 as such scheme is described in the application from the Operator to the ministry dated February 7, 1997, is hereby approved, subject to terms and conditions herein contained.
- 2. The water disposal interval must be in the Debolt "A" pool.
- 3. A record of volume of salt water disposed of through this well must be included on a Monthly Injection/Disposal Statement, in the prescribed form, which should be submitted to the Energy and Minerals Division not later than the 25th day of the month following the reported month.
- 4. The disposal/injection pressure at the sandface must not exceed the formation fracture pressure.
- 5. This approval may be modified or rescinded by the Director of Engineering and Operations Branch at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
