PRODUCED WATER DISPOSAL SPECIAL PROJECT CANCELLATION

CNRL LADYFERN d-44-H/94-H-1 (WA# 13644) LADYFERN FIELD – BELLOY FORMATION

The subject well was drilled and completed in the Slave Point 'A' pool in early 2001 as a gas well. At the end of 2001, the well was completed in the Montney but the zone was immediately abandoned and in early 2002 the well was completed in the Bluesky formation. Approval for salt water disposal into the Belloy formation was granted on July 5th, 2004, however the zone was never completed. On November 7th, 2019, Canadian Natural Resources Ltd. indicated having no plans for reactivation of this well and concurred that cancellation of the disposal approval is appropriate.

Pursuant to the *Oil and Gas Activities Act (OGAA)* section 75(2)(b), the Commission may cancel, suspend or amend a designation (iii) if the Commission considers that the designation is spent, or (iv) if the Commission considers that the designation is no longer appropriate, including, without limitation, for reasons of (a) public safety, (b) protection of the environment, or (c) conservation of petroleum and natural gas resources.

The Special Project Approval 04-02-009 for the Ladyfern field, Belloy formation well CNRL Ladyfern d-44-H/94-H-1 (WA 13644) is hereby cancelled under section 75(2)(b) of OGAA. In accordance with Section 75(2)(b)(iii), the Commission considers that the designation is spent.
